PROJECT CARE (CARE AT THE END-OF-LIFE FOR RESIDENTS IN HOMES FOR THE ELDERLY)

Nursing homes provide care and comfort for patients with limitations in bodily functions or who require social support. Started in 2009, Project CARE is a collaboration between TTSH and Nursing Homes in Central Singapore to provide holistic End-of-Life care for Nursing Home residents.

Through capability building and the provision of specialised palliative care, TTSH works closely with our colleagues from partner Nursing Homes to enable residents to have their end-of-life care choices respected and live out their final days in dignity and comfort.
